Why is this construction project needed?

While our goal is to expand our facility to enhance our ministry, immediate needs include addressing major structural wall and room system issues in the current gathering/office spaces, including the eventual structural failure of the western roof and wall.

What will renovation and expansion provide?

- A welcoming “front door”, including a larger gathering space in the narthex to promote fellowship and building relationships
- An education center, including additional walled classrooms, a youth room, and a multi-use space to accommodate ever-changing needs
- A larger, more conventional kitchen with an efficient flow to gathering space (narthex) and fellowship center
- A fellowship center promoting community, fellowship, and a place for our children to participate in physical activities such as games

What is the cost?

The original estimate is \$1.3-\$1.45 million. However, we are working to reduce the cost by opting out of non-essential elements, which can be added in the future if funds permit.

How does my pledge affect my annual giving?

It doesn't! This commitment is over and above your traditional offering of our Good Shepherd ministries.

When do I make my pledge?

Your response form—along with other giving materials—will be distributed at the campaign kick-off meeting Sunday, March 5, or delivered to those unable to attend. You are encouraged to make your pledge once you have had time to review the materials and prayerfully consider how God is asking you to participate.

When does my pledge begin?

While this is a three year campaign, contributions may be made as a one-time gift or distributed over three years with payments made monthly, semi-annually or annually. Gifts received within the first year—particularly by March 2018—are crucial to reaching our goal of an additional \$250k cash on-hand in order to proceed with the scheduled groundbreaking in May/June 2018.

How can I make my giving decision?

Be informed by reviewing the capital campaign materials and being part of the special events and worship celebrations happening at Good Shepherd. Remember that your giving is part of your relationship with God. God gives to us because God loves us; your giving is one way you love back.

How can I make this appeal a success?

By praying for the mission and ministry we share at Good Shepherd and making a heartfelt and generous response.

May I give stocks, real estate, insurance, or other gifts-in-kind in addition to cash gifting?

This Renovation and Expansion Project Will:

- Doubles the size of the Gathering Space in order to be welcoming and inviting; decreases the bottleneck of people trying to get to the education rooms while others are trying to go to and from the sanctuary; provides a space for ministry, community and relationship-building.
- Improves Education Space by offering additional walled classrooms for a better teaching environment where students and teachers can hear one another.
- Offers a new Kitchen and Fellowship Center that provides more efficiency and better flow; a space for meals to be both cooked and served during the educational hour; and a space for both new ministries and for the community to use.
- Provides new office space located right off the entrance for better visibility and security.
- Solves the moisture and leaking problems of the current western wall and roof, and replaced.
